Our IB students recently received 3 awards from NYIT in their Traffic Pioneers Competition. They had to design a campaign to advertise Traffic Safety Awareness. From Sunday 13th to Wednesday 16th IB students will encourage their fellow students to be safe on the road, on their bicycles and behind the wheel of cars.

Combining their CAS fundraising for charity the IB students will use the campaign to raise money for our community's less fortunate. Your support is needed. Look at the events below and see how you can contribute to your child's traffic education, as well as helping those less fortunate.

SUNDAY 13th December

Teacher's car wash, students can watch their IB peers' wash cars with a competitive twist.

Grades 1/2/3 will watch presentations on road safety, with activities. There is a coloring book with educational activities collated by the IB students. The cost of the book is 2JD, payable to the homeroom teacher. The book will be sold throughout the week, each day for this week only. The children can order and receive their copy the same day from their IB friends.

MONDAY 14th December

Bicycle race for grades 4-7. Students will learn tips on *staying safe on their bicycle*; and enjoy either competing or supporting their friends. The cost of competing is JD 2.00 (proceeds to go to the IB Charity Fund). Please come to reception before 8 am to sign up and pay Miss Michelle. Bake sale, please send red, orange or green cup cakes with your child for sale in the bake sale for upper and lower grades. Don't forget to give your child a little extra pocket money to buy a Jello cup or Cup cake. Proceeds go to the IB charity fund.

A Jordanian rally race car with its driver will visit our school to talk to the children about driving safely; also an accident survivor will give the children a real victim's perspective.

Red/Green/Orange color day – students may participate in the IB campaign by wearing these three colors alone or together. Only these colors are acceptable. Students not joining in our activity should wear their school uniform as usual.

Movie Night – in the evening there will be short educational films and an episode of Top Gear as a prelude to the main feature film “A Christmas Carol” (2009, the latest animated version).
